This course explores several psychoanalytical papers on countertransference considered essential for the field of psychoanalysis. They represent a range of theoretical and clinical perspectives. The class will focus on their practical application in the clinical work.

WEBINAR OBJECTIVES:

1. Identify the dynamics and role of countertransference in psychoanalytic treatment through reading and discussion of articles from a variety of periods and theoretical/technical approaches.
2. Explore the historical evolution of psychoanalytic technique and how this evolution influences the work for modern psychoanalytic advances in treatment.
3. Provide opportunities for students to make connections between reading assignments and their own clinical and life experiences.
